All bird houses will be donated to Habitat for Humanity’s BirdFest auction on May 1, 2, and 3, and will be auctioned off as part of BirdFest.

BirdFest will take place at habitat for Humanity, 339 Witt Street on May 1, 2, and 3 from 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. and Saturday from 9 a.m. – 1 p.m.

The live Auction will be held on Saturday, May 3 from 6:00 – 10:00 or whenever the auction is completed. Students submitting birdhouses will receive on complimentary ticket (a \$25.00 value).
